Please make a note of the following details for the students:

- **Student Rehearsal/Concert Arrival:**

Students **must stay after school with Mrs.Wells until the concert.**

This will allow them time to rehearse, eat, get in costume and watch the middle school choir perform. Please arrive only 15 minutes before the scheduled concert you wish to watch so as to not disrupt the current performance or rehearsal. The Art display area will be available throughout the entire evening if you need a place to wait for a performance!

Joust Costume Assignments

***** Students must bring costume items to rehearsal on April 27th*****

This will allow costumes to be checked for proper fit and dress code.

Knights:

Flat sheet Tabard (Cut a rectangular piece of plain colored fabric big enough to drape on both sides of the student like a poncho with a hole cut in the center for their head). Students may decorate it.

Belt (ribbon or any thing that can tie the tabard around the waist).

Dark colored shirt/pants/shoes.

- King Arthur, French Soldiers and the French King should dress as knights. Extra props will be provided for these characters.

Damsels:

Dress (long dress, with sleeves or a long sleeve shirt underneath, that goes past the knees in length)

OR

long sleeve shirt and a long skirt.

Students should decorate their hair with

ribbons, braids, clips, flower crowns etc.

- French Ladies should dress as damsels.

Special Roles: These outfits are up to interpretation!

- Merlin will be provided a robe and wizard hat. Tips - Beard, mystical looking clothes, include imagery of moons and stars.
- The Messenger should dress as a postal worker! Tips - Messenger bag, khakis, hat etc.
- Jesters should create a colorful outfit full of clown-like whimsy! Tips- Leggings, tutus, patches, ribbons tied in random places, jester hats, beads, colorful makeup etc.
- French Soldiers (Some of our jesters also have this role) Please make sure that they make a simple sheet Tabard to throw over their jester costume!
